

European Science Days Award for Best Essays on Signaling Theory

The ESD invites essays on “Signaling Theory”, in English, from individuals of up to 30 years of age. The essays can be written from the perspective of any of the social or biological sciences – anthropology, economics, political science, sociology, and behavioural ecology.

In step 1, applicants are invited to present an abstract of their intended essay (maximum 600 words) and an updated CV, by **July 31st, 2010**. The Jury, composed of three members of the Faculty of the European Science Days 2010, will select those that shall be invited to present the full essay. The decision of the Jury will be remitted to the applicants by September 7th, 2010.

In step 2, the full essays (maximum 6000 words point 12 font, inclusive of footnotes, bibliography and appendixes) are to be submitted by January 31, 2011.

Abstracts and full essays should be in pdf format, spell checked, and accompanied by a cover page with the author's name and affiliation, the essay title and return email address.

Essays that do not meet these ESD guidelines will be rejected.
